The Monterey Peninsula is a semi-urban environment, which means that public transportation is limited. On the arrival and departure days it is important to leave two hours between the beginning and ending of class to reach the bus and airport in Monterey. If you are driving from the Bay Area on Saturday morning, please leave enough time. The traffic on 101 can be congested around San Jose by 9:00AM. Allow about 2-1/2 hours to drive.

CLASS STRUCTURE: Around mid- morning we will take a break and a light snack with coffee and tea will be provided. There will be an hour lunch break starting between 12:30 and 1:00. Many good restaurants are close by in Carmel Valley Village. I will bring a list of local restaurants on the first day of class. There is also a microwave oven, a toaster and a large refrigerator. If you bring your lunch, or go to a near-by deli, you can find a nice spot at Los Laureles or in a nearby park to relax. The room is available after class until 8:00PM for sessions or your use.
